

USA

I've been fortunate to have had a long and exciting career in pediatric dentistry with a special focus and interest in dental traumatology. My dental training at both Harvard School of Dental Medicine (HSDM) and Boston Children's Hospital (BCH) provided me with high-quality role models in two unique clinical and academic settings. My profession has been split between a private clinical practice at Chestnut Dental Associates in Needham MA, academia at HSDM, and hospital dentistry at BCH. My fellow pediatric dentist, Dr. Stephen Shusterman, and I founded and worked in a large multispecialty group practice which has grown to three locations in the Greater Boston area. At BCH I treated patients, trained residents, participated in clinical research, and helped administer the department - spending the majority of my career as Associate Dentist-in-Chief. At HSDM I rose to Professor of Developmental Biology, served on many committees, and helped administer their pre-doctoral program in pediatric dentistry.

My interest in dental traumatology started early in my career when I came into contact with Dr. Anthony Hargreaves and Dr. Jens Andreasen. While Dr. Hargreaves was Dentist-in-Chief of my department, he asked me to help him coedit and contribute to his seminal text, The Management of Traumatized Anterior Teeth in Children. I was likewise inspired by Dr. Andreasen's lectures at HSDM and began to follow his publications, which were groundbreaking and influenced my management of dental traumatic injuries.

As a young clinician I soon realized how challenging and rewarding it was to manage a dental injury to emotionally and physically traumatized children and to

work with their parents. I found great satisfaction inserting calm into this highly charged situation and assuring the family that I could treat not only the acute problem, but create a satisfactory long-term outcome.

Since I worked in both a hospital and a private practice location, I had the opportunity to work with a large and varied population base. I was able to develop not only my clinical skills, but also engage in clinical research, especially in the field of traumatology and its related field of child abuse. The excitement of discovery through research became an integral part of my career.

Studies of dental trauma and child abuse represent approximately one-third of my over 100 publications in dental and medical journals, texts, and monographs (see references). This research allowed me also to collaborate with many pre-doctoral, post-doctoral, and staff colleagues over the course of my career. Stimulating their interest in dental traumatology and research continually enriched my BCH and HSDM experience.

Membership in the IADT has expanded my knowledge of dental traumatology and has given me the opportunity to make many professional friendships throughout the United States and around the world.
